We also note that the Long Term Incentive Plan is based upon targets of EBITDA and operating margin, which are set annually. The company, however, has not provided quantitative disclosure of these targets. In future filings, please disclose the specific performance targets used to determine incentive amounts, or provide in your response letter a more detailed analysis as to how disclosure would cause competitive harm, given that disclosure would occur only after the time period for each target has passed and actual company results are known. To the extent that you will disclose the performance targets in future filings, please provide us with your proposed draft disclosure.
